Supply List: Will be given to students after registered in class.

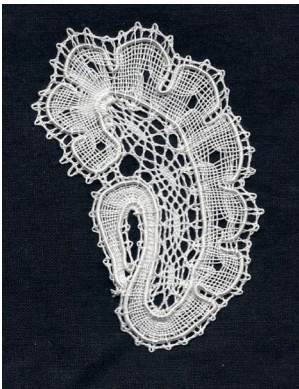
Mirecourt Bobbin Lace

Bobbin lace has been made in the French town of Mirecourt since the 16th century. This bold and distinct lace is created of both tape lace and free form motifs, consisting of flowers, leaves, scrolls, and elegantly flowing tapes. The defining characteristic of Mirecourt lace is the heavy raised cordonnet which appears only on the finished side of the lace. Mirecourt is made of a medium weight cotton thread and the unusual wrapped cord, and the bold design motifs may be joined by simple fillings. The finest examples may have decorative tapes, layering of flower petals, and lace “buttons”. Mirecourt lace is rich in texture yet quick and simple to create.
