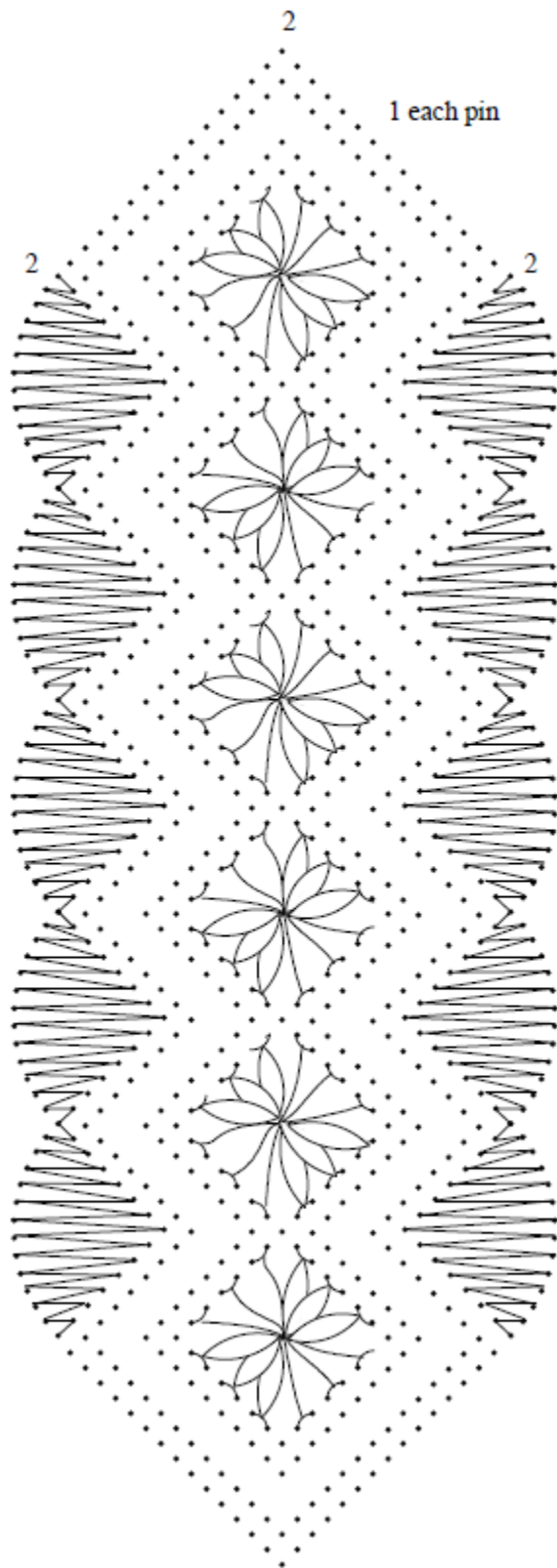
If there are websites with free patterns for the type of lace that you like, please let Michele Germanson know so that she can look at these sites to get patterns for this newsletter.
